Track



Our race track has a very smooth and fast layout resulting in lap times around 12 and 13 seconds for 1/8 and 1/10 IC track cars, respectively.

Technical data of the track:

- Length: 210 m
- Width: 4.0 m
- Grain: 0.8

The cars are driven in clockwise direction. The long straight is followed by a banked curve.


The pit lane is directly in front of the rostrum.

Track



On the rostrum there is space for 10 drivers, additionally there is a separated area for a referee or the race director, equipped with a monitor for displaying the current race data.



Drivers' pits



The pits can comprise 72 drivers. The pits are completely roofed and have a stone floor; additionally they are wind-protected by wooden walls in south, west and north direction.



Every table is equipped with a highly plain tabletop, an additional shelf space above, and, of course, enough 230V AC power sockets (German "Schuko", compatible with the Europlug CEE 7/16) for every driver.

Drivers' pits



In order to track the current heat every row of tables is equipped with a monitor displaying the current race data. There is enough electric light in the pits to allow drivers to service and prepare the cars even after sundown.

If the number of drivers exceeds 72, we will establish a big tent with a solid wooden floor, many windows, plain tables and enough AC power plugs for everyone.

Adjacent to the pits three drivers can true their tires at the same time.

Therefore a powerful 12V rail for the tire truers is installed. Brushes and collecting containers will ensure a clean environment.

The place for truing tires has also a workbench with "big" tools like a pillar drill, a bench grinder and a bench vise.

Furthermore, there are two air blow guns supplied by a very powerful compressor with a huge air tank for endless car cleaning.

Directly around the corner there is a big water case for cleaning the car bodies.

Time keeping



The time keeping is built up in a separated climatized building with a very large desk for at least four persons.

The most important features of the time keeping are:

- Race director and time keeper can overview the whole track
- Fully redundant time keeping with two independent time loops, two AMB RC4 decoders and two desktop PCs
- All time keeping electronics backed-up by a UPS
- Loudspeaker announcement via a PA system which covers the whole site
- Redundant network printers for printing the race results
- Fixed-line telephone connection to the technical approval

On regular training weekends the time keeping is in service, too, so that the drivers can monitor their lap times.



Parking and camping



Directly at the race track there are a lot of parking slots. The area for camping has place for 35 caravans/campervans.



It is possible to provide 230V AC power to every caravan/campervan.

Parking and camping



There are permanent sanitary facilities including shower rooms in a separate brick building directly at the track.




For those who do not like to camp at the race track there are many rooms available in Türkheim itself, but also in Bad Wörishofen which is only 6km away.


Gastronomic service



On race events at our race club we will also provide a full gastronomic service rich in variety for the whole event directly at the track.
Nevertheless, there is also a gastronomic service on training weekends including a variety of beverages and warm meals.



Location



The MCC Türkheim race track is located in Türkheim (red dot in the map on the left) at the A96 motorway.

The A96 connects Memmingen (green dot) and Munich (blue dot).

In Memmingen the A96 crosses the A7 which is the large north-south route midway through Germany.

From Türkheim, Memmingen and Munich are distant only 39km and 83km respectively.

These cities also have an airport (FMM and MUC). This means that the race track can be reached easily from anywhere of Europe.
